Whistleblower Policy:

The Aloha Region adheres to all applicable rules and regulations including the Code of Conduct for USA Volleyball. Current members are encouraged to immediately report in writing any observations in the violation of any rules, regulations or Code of Conduct of USA Volleyball Aloha Region that affect member(s) of USA Volleyball – Aloha Region. The report should be as specific as possible to include name of the member committing the violation, the name of the of the injured party, the infraction, dates, times, locations and any other pertinent information and send to the Regional Commissioner so that the Aloha Region may investigate and determine an appropriate course of action.

Retaliation Prohibited

The Aloha Region prohibits any form of retaliation by any individual against anyone for filing or making a good-faith complaint or assisting in the investigation of a complaint in good-faith, whether the complaint is found to have merit. Like harassment, retaliation is a serious offense punishable by immediate disciplinary action, up to and including suspension of the person's membership with USA Volleyball.

If any current member feels that he or she is the target of retaliation in violation of this policy, the member should immediately report the problem to the Regional Commissioner.

WHISTLEBLOWER POLICY

The Aloha Region adheres to all applicable rules and regulations including the Code of Conduct for USA Volleyball.

Members are encouraged to immediately report in writing any observations in the violation of any rules, regulations or Code of Conduct of USA Volleyball Aloha Region that affect the member(s) of USA Volleyball – Aloha Region.

The Aloha Region prohibits retaliation against a current member because he or she (or a person on his or her behalf) reports or is about to report the incident to the Aloha Region. We further prohibit retaliation against any member who is requested by the investigative committee to participate in an investigation, hearing, or inquiry.

If any current member feels that he or she is the target of retaliation in violation of this policy, the member should immediately report the problem to the Regional Commissioner – Aloha Region.

Acting in Good Faith:

Anyone making a report concerning inappropriate, unethical, or illegal conduct must be acting in good faith and have reasonable grounds for believing the information disclosed indicates inappropriate conduct or actions, or a violation of law or regulations. Any untrue reports which prove to have been made maliciously or knowingly to be false, will be considered a serious disciplinary offense.
